The YTA 50th Anniversary Bursary

The Yukon Teachers' Association commemorating its 50th anniversary in 2005 established a bursary [\$500] with the intention of supporting one or more Yukon students pursuing a post secondary education opportunity.

The applicants will be assessed using the following criteria:

- The award will be made to promote a formal post secondary training or education activity –trades training, college or university.
- The award will be made without regard to the specific area of study provided completion of the programme will result in the granting of a training certificate, trades ticket, diploma or degree.
- Preference will be given to applicants who have completed the major portion of their public school education in Yukon schools.
- Awards may be made without regard to an applicant's receipt of other financial awards.
- Where two or more applicants appear to qualify, financial need may be taken into consideration.
- While the bursary may not necessarily be awarded each year, more than one bursary may be considered in a given year.
- Applications must be received at the YTA office by August 31 of the award year.
