YTA's submission recommended: "*coverage for disablement of mental stress or disablement caused by mental stress*"; *specify coverage for diagnosed psychiatric and psychological injury or illness; and expressly state harassment, bullying, or abuse of authority, are not normal work pressures, or a normal part of employment.*"
